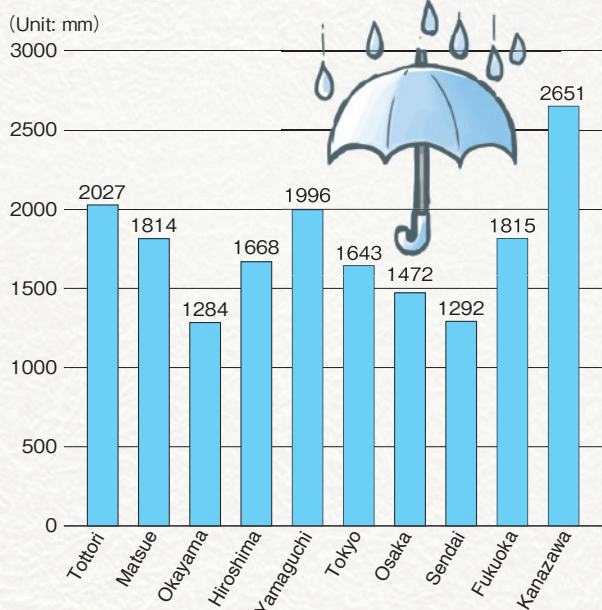


3 Mild, Temperate Climate with Abundant Natural Resources

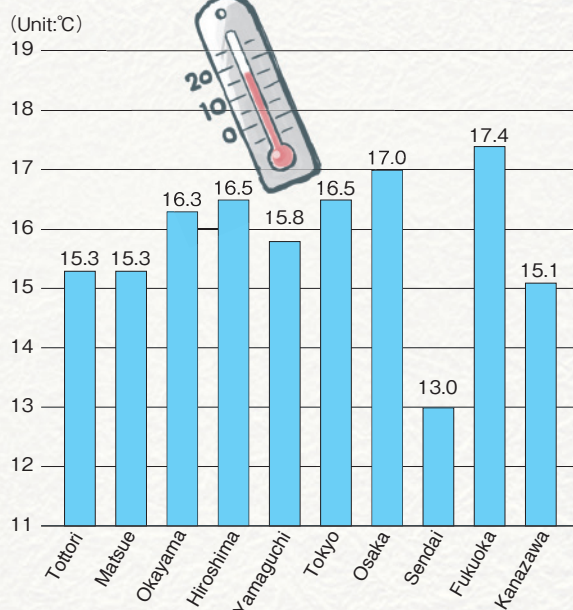
